***STATE FAIR ENTRY FORMS AND PAYMENT MUST
BE SUBMITTED TO THE NWMTPA BY AUGUST 1ST.***

- You must have a paid NWMTPA full membership to compete at the state fair as an NWMTPA member.
- If you are planning on pulling at the fair, please download and complete entry form, and mail it to the address above with a check for \$12 payable to the NWMTPA before August 1, 2011.
- All that is needed is the entry form and \$12 payment. You will fill out the vendor-input form at the fair.
- Please fill out the entry form COMPLETELY AND NEATLY.
- The entry form on the website allows you to type in the information and print the form out.
- Only one entry form and one \$12 entry fee needs to be paid per pulling vehicle.
- Be sure to enter the correct class number for the class you are pulling in.
